

What can I do about hearing loss?

While hearing loss is not reversible, most age- or noise-related losses can be managed and often compensated for. Sometimes that means medication or surgery. But just as eyeglasses are used to correct most vision problems, hearing instruments are used to treat most kinds of hearing loss.

Any treatment starts with a screening of your hearing by a doctor or hearing professional. Once you know the nature and extent of the hearing loss, you will be able to make your own decision about treatment.
